### Executive Order information

Long title	An Executive Order to retain the Honorable Aiden Burke as Student General Counsel in an acting capacity, until the Assembly votes on the question of whether to reconfirm him

Pursuant to my authority under the University of Michigan Ann Arbor All-Campus Constitution, I, the duly elected President, do hereby direct as follows:

In the interest of ensuring the continued legal representation of the Central Student Government in Central Student Judiciary cases, as well as ensuring the continued legal advice and expertise of the Student General Counsel, **The Honorable Aiden Michael Burke of the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts**, is retained in an acting capacity as the Central Student Government's Student General Counsel, a role he has held under the previous administration. Prior to serving as Student General Counsel, Mr. Burke served as Elections Director for the Fall 2024 and Winter 2025 Elections, and was the Independent Special Prosecutor for the Fall 2023 and Winter 2024 Elections. Mr. Burke is to remain in the position in an acting capacity until the Assembly votes on the question of whether to reconfirm him.
