Long Title	An Executive Order of the Central Student Government of the University of Michigan to Formally Establish the Graduate Strategic Task Force Dedicated to Comprehensive Engagement, Strategic Empowerment, and the Centralization of Graduate and Professional Student Needs within University Governance.

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the Central Student Government, I hereby direct as follows:

The Central Student Government (CSG) hereby establishes the Graduate Strategic Task Force (GSTF). This body is tasked with creating a comprehensive engagement plan to ensure graduate and professional students are central to CSG's strategy of empowering the entire student body.

The Task Force shall be comprised of seven (7) members, structured to ensure balanced oversight and specialized insight:

- Five (5) Graduate or Professional students appointed by the President.
- One (1) Ex-Officio representative from the Executive Branch.
- One (1) Ex-Officio representative from the Legislative Branch.

The GSTF shall identify systemic barriers to graduate student involvement, audit current resource allocation, and identify programming better suited for graduate students. This mission serves to preserve and uplift the diverse contributions of the graduate community as an integral part of the University and our student government.

This committee is also to identify specific areas, such as housing, childcare, research funding, and career placement, where CSG can better advocate for graduate-specific needs to the University Administration.

The findings and strategic recommendations of the GSTF shall be shared with relevant University leaders as well as delivered to the leadership of all three branches of the Central Student Government to signal unified student support for the continued advancement of graduate life and academic success.

A formal presentation of the Task Force's strategic roadmap shall be made to the Assembly upon the completion of its initial term.
